15. Born in April 20th, 1965 at Ampati Village of erstwhile Garo Hills District in the State of Assam (Undivided Assam)
16. Completed schooling and passed out matriculation in 1982 from Government High School, Ampati, West Garo Hills
17. Studied Pre-University (Sc) in St. Anthony's College, Shillong (1982-1984).
18. Studied and passed out MBBS (1984-1990) from Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal (RIMS), the erstwhile North Eastern Regional Medical College (NERMC), Imphal.
19. He had been active in politics from student life and had been a Youth Congress activist while being a student.
20. Held different positions in the Governing Body of Students Council Medical of the College (RIMS), Imphal and contributed substantially in bringing unity and harmony between the outstation students and the local students of the Medical College and had been involved in getting the Medical College exempted from frequent agitational programmes usually sponsored by Local NGOs.
21. Practiced as a Private Medical Practitioner at private Clinic at Tura (January 1990 - May 1991).
22. In May, 1991 joined and served as Medical & Health Officer at Zikzak PHC, West Garo Hills under Government of Meghalaya.
23. In January 15<sup>th</sup>, 1993 left the Government Service to enter into active politics.
24. In February, 1993 got elected as Independent MLA from 58 – Ampatigre L.A, Constituency.

**Positions / Posts Held :**

1. February, 1993 till September, 1993 held the post of Chairman Meghalaya Transport Corporation (MTC).
2. November, 1996 till February, 1998 held office of Parliamentary Secretary Government of Meghalaya.
3. From 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 1998 till September, 1999 held office of the Cabinet Minister, and held departments such as Cooperation, Fisheries, Taxation etc., under Government of Meghalaya.
4. From 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2001 to 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2003 served as Cabinet Minister, and held portfolios such as Taxation, IPR, etc. Government of Meghalaya.
5. March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2003 till 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 served as Cabinet Minister, Government of Meghalaya and looked after Taxation, PWD, Home (P), Education (both Higher

& Technical Education and Elementary, and Mass Education), Forest & Environment. Information Technology Election, IPR, etc., Departments.

6. 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 till 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2005 served as Deputy Chief Minister, Government of Meghalaya.
7. From 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 - March 2008, served as Deputy Chief Minister, Government of Meghalaya and looking after Planning, IPR, Election, PID, Power including Non-Conventional Energy, Re-organisation Departments.
8. May 2009 served as Deputy Chief Minister I/C Finance, Power & Non Conventional Energy, Health & F.W., IPR, Horticulture, Home (Passport) Administrative Reforms.
9. Chief Minister from 20/4/2010 till 6/3/2018.
10. April 2010 appointed as Chairperson North Eastern Regional Power Committee (NERPC).
11. On 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 assumed the office of Chief Minister of Meghalaya. He also held various posts of Party functionary of Indian National Congress in the State of Meghalaya.
12. From the year 1998-1999, held position of General Secretary, District Congress Committee, West Garo Hills.
13. From the year 1999 to September, 2000 held position of President, District Congress Committee West Garo Hills.
14. From November, 2000 till November 2007, held the position of the General Secretary, Meghalaya Pradesh Congress Committee, I/C Frontal Wings etc.
15. Actively involves in mobilisation of Frontal Wings of Indian National Congress in the State of Meghalaya.

**Others :**

1. Actively involves in social work and takes keen interest in mobilization of women for social awareness and socio-economic advancement particularly in the rural areas.
2. Regularly involves in various activities of youth development programmes including activities in sports, promotion and preservation of culture and had motivated and supported formation of over 200 Youth Clubs/Societies.
3. Personally active in undertaking social work and is the Chief Patron of Ampati Youth Welfare Club which is the premier organization in promoting youth activities in the field of sports and culture in various parts of Garo Hills.

4. He is also a founder member of Mirachel Foundation which is associated with many Social Service Groups and is implementing various welfare programmes locally.
5. He actively associates with traditional institution like Nokma Council in Garo Hills which is the premier organization of the traditional heads of Garos and he is a strong advocate of empowerment of people and traditional institutions.
6. Strong advocate of measures for Social and Economic Empowerment of people and Traditional Institutions and was instrumental in giving the shape of the Present Guidelines for Implementation of the NREGS in Meghalaya involving community and traditional institutions wherein the Village Employment Council (VEC) propose and implement the schemes. The VEC is a non political entity.
7. On 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 Dr. Mukul Sangma, sworn in as the Chief Minister of Meghalaya.
8. On 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2013 sworn in for the second time as Chief Minister of Meghalaya.
9. In March 2018, contested from two constituencies namely 53-Ampati and 41- Songsak constituency and won from both constituencies as INC candidate.
10. Presently holding the post of Leader of Opposition.
