The House met at 10.00 a.m. on the 18th March, 2009 with the Hon'ble Speaker in the Chair. The day was devoted for the transaction of Government Business.

QUESTIONS :

Unstarred Question No. 1 was disposed of.

At this point of time, there was pandemonium and the Opposition Members staged a walk out.

DEBATE ON GOVERNORS' ADDRESS :

Shri J.D. Rymbai, MLA supported the Motion of Thanks moved by James Sangma and lauded the Government for its achievements in the implementation of the central schemes. He also urged upon the Government to make roads where there are none to enable the people to bring their produce to the market, the sick and the infirm to the PHCs, CHCs or Sub-Centres for treatment. As it is now, they have to be brought by horses. He also was in favour of tying up with committed NGOs/voluntary agencies on a PPP model since the State is facing shortage of doctors which should be implemented as early as possible for the benefit of the rural people living in the rural areas.

Shri Marcuse N. Marak, MLA and Shri Omillo K. Sangma, MLA also supported the Motion of Thanks. They spoke broadly on the achievements of the Government with regard to the implementation of the central schemes.
